
Spiders belong to a group of animals called **arachnids** – and arachnids come in more than 100,000 species. They have two main body parts, called the **cephalothorax** (front) and the **abdomen**. On the abdomen are the **spinnerets**, which are used to produce the spider's web.

Spiders have eight legs, and most have six or eight eyes. Their mouths consist of two parts – jaws and fangs – that work together to hold prey while the spider paralyzes it with its venom. Behind the jaws are the first pair of legs, called **pedipalps**, which are used to sense objects the spider encounters.

- 6 round brad fasteners

How to Build Your Spider

- 1. Cut out the spider's body and legs.
- 2. Place the legs on top of the body, overlapping the circles with matching letters.
- 3. Use the end of each brad to poke through the circles and attach the legs to the body.
